


Curtis Moore (Cladding Systems) Ltd. is committed to driving out acts of modern day slavery from within its own business and that from its supply chains. The Company acknowledges responsibility to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and will ensure transparency within suppliers of goods and services to the organisation.

As part of the Company's due diligence process into slavery and human trafficking, the supplier approval process will incorporate a review of the controls undertaken by the supplier. Imported produce from sources outside the UK and EU are potentially more at risk for slavery/human trafficking issues. The level of management control required for these sources will be continually monitored.

The Company Directors and Senior Management shall take responsibility for implementing this policy statement and its objectives and shall provide adequate resources (training etc.) to ensure that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place within its supply chain organisations.
